
Parent Code of Conduct

Below is a list of requirements that as a ProFormance parent you should adhere to whilst your child attends our programme.

We reserve the right to remove any parent, and if appropriate the players, when the parents code of conduct is seriously breached.

Parents accept our philosophy and methodology, using small areas, and small sided games to develop ability.

Parents must remain the parental viewing area and must not enter the field unless there is a medical emergency.

Encroachment on the playing area will result in the parent being asked to leave the facility.

It is strictly forbidden for parents to 'coach' or shout to their children. Coaches are the only person authorised to deliver technical and tactical advice. Gentle encouragement and praise to both teams is encouraged on matchdays.

Parents are required to conduct themselves in a civil manner at all times. Grievances and complaints must be taken up with the centre manager or more appropriately the office.

The use of foul, abusive, homophobic or racist language is strictly prohibited.

Alcoholic beverages, drugs or cigarettes of any description are strictly prohibited from being taken / used at all ProFormance sessions.

In the event of a player being injured or taken ill, by signing this code of conduct you accept our staff may accompany your child to hospital if admission and/or further treatment is required.
